- 8) A reminder to all stallholders – you are responsible for clearing away your stall – the immediate area around your stall must be cleared - any rubbish you must take away and dispose of.
- 9) Volunteers are needed to run the toy stall.
- 10) There needs to be a review of the entrance fee. Suggested 50p adults and 10p child.
- 11) As there was so few present some decisions have had to be deferred to a later date.
